#### Dear Parents/Caregivers.



This strand is about how Jesus invites us all to share in his life and to carry on his mission of creating the Kingdom of God on earth, as it is in heaven.


#### Year 5-6 "Jesus - The fullness of God's revelation."




## What's happening in Room 2?
