Tuesday 15th August - 9:30am in the church.






Room 2 Marys


Our Mathematics focus at present is measurement.

A friendly St Mary's welcome to Charlotte who is joining us for school visits at the moment as she completes her transition to school programme.


Charlotte will be joining us as a 5yr old at the end of this month. Room 2 are looking forward to visiting her at Wakari Kindergarten next week.
