We have been continuing our learning about 2D shapes, looked at symmetry within shapes and have had fun creating artworks using different 2D shapes.




Next week we will be exploring the features of 3D shapes.

The 6th of June is the Feast Day of St Marcellin Champagnat, founder of the Marist Brothers. The Marist Brothers taught extensively throughout New Zealand and the Pacific. In Christchurch they taught at Xavier College (now Catholic Cathedral College) and Marist Brothers High School in Greymouth (now John Paul II High School) and Timaru (now Sacred Heart School). Many Rugby Union and Rugby League clubs around the country were started by brothers or their pupils, and many of these clubs still exist today. Although most of the Brothers are now elderly and have left working in schools, the Champagnat Partnership ensures their work and charism stays alive.
