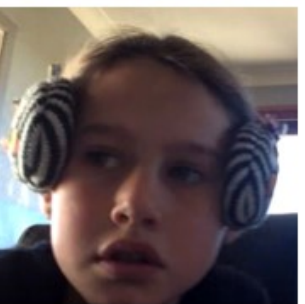

Fish in a tree—wear a hat day!

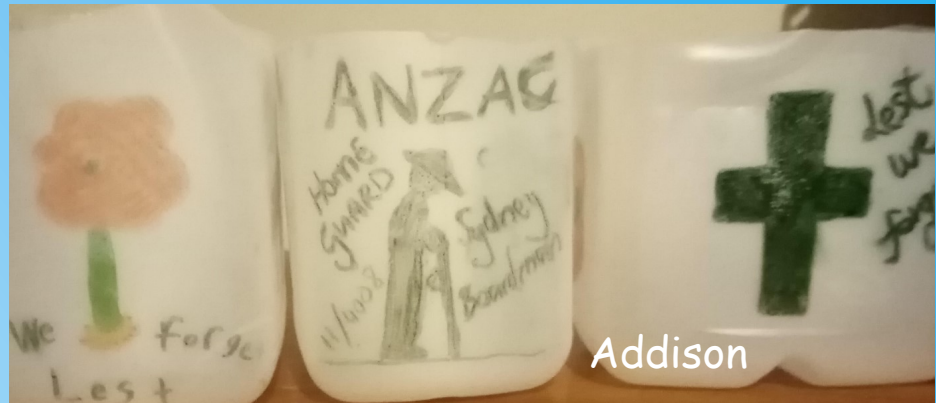
