
Junior Room: Room 2 — Mrs Dillon (Whaea Dillon)



Middle Room: Room 1 — Mrs Hammer (Whaea Hammer)

Room One have been collecting information and then graphing this. These photos are of us collecting the information from our peers. We found we had to have a system in place to check who we had asked and who we needed to ask. So it took us a few times to get accurate information.



Senior Room: Room 3 — Ms Donnelly (Whaea Donnelly)

We have focused again on basic facts - using equipment to show what they mean. 2×10 and 10×2 will give the same answer, but are grouped differently. The first number always tells the number of groups and the second number shows the size of each group so 2×10 means 2 groups of 10 and 10×2 means 10 groups of 2. It is helpful to know this when learning times tables and using the chart to find answers.



Senior Room: Room 3 — Mrs Guthrie (Whaea Guthrie)

Hearing You Counselling Service

Following the disappointing news of the withdrawal of Chatbus due to financial issues, our Catholic Kahui Ako primary schools got together to find a possible way to provide this support which makes such a big difference to the well-being of our students.
