



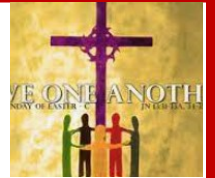

We shared ideas for what to put on and in our cards and then got to work. As you can see, a lot of co-operation and

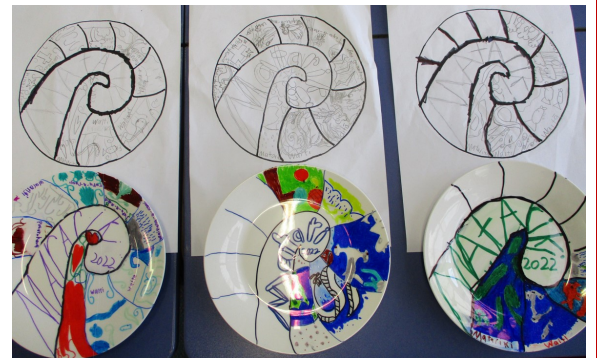
team-work saw us each produce a card we were proud of.

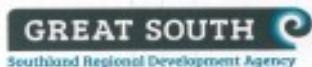
