



This week we finished our learning from the Holy Spirit strand and will be showing our gifts of love and kindness in our words and actions as we help to share the message of Jesus in our world.






Senior Room: Room 3 - Mrs Donnelly (Whaea Donnelly)

Maths Challenge

The questions asked were, "How many triangles can you see? How many squares can you see? Can you see a hexagon?" After initialing thinking there were only 15 squares, about 23 triangles and no hexagons, the children realised there were so many more. They found small, middle sized and large squares and triangles and 1 irregular hexagon. It was a great challenge as there were no right answers - and everyone had to justify how they came up with their results. As an aside - this is a great book if you are looking for a new novel to read.
