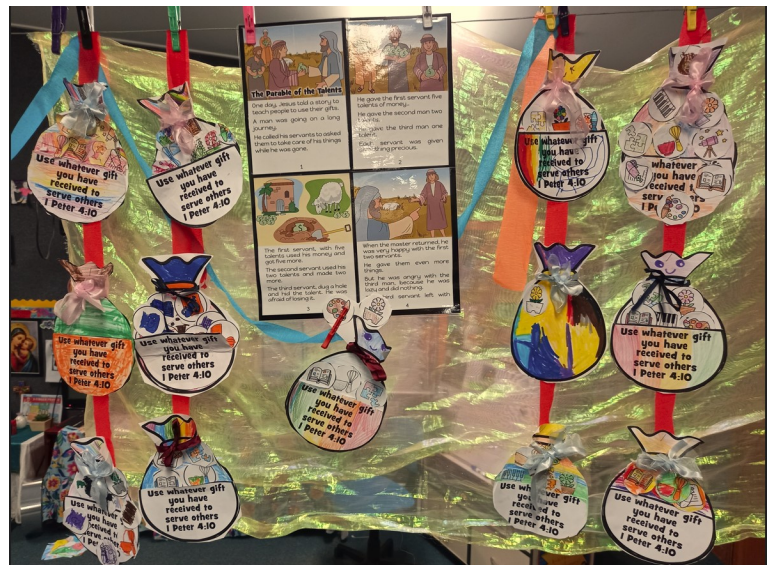

This week we finished our learning from the Holy Spirit strand and will be showing our gifts of love and kindness in our words and actions as we help to share the message of Jesus in our world.

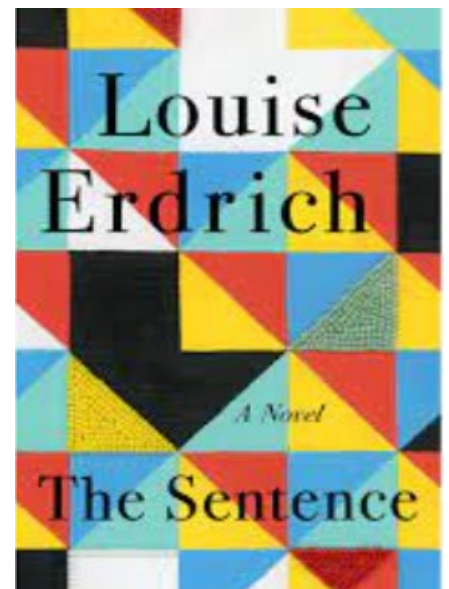

They found small, middle sized and large squares and triangles and 1 irregular hexagon. It was a great challenge as there were no right answers - and everyone had to justify how they came up with their results.
