At Parlez SLT we are committed to helping children and young people fulfil their potential in life by removing communication barriers.

We offer high quality evidence-based intervention for children who have any of the following issues:

- Late talkers: saying very little or struggling to produce language at the same level as their peers.
- Difficulty understanding what they are told.
- Unclear speech e.g., due to using a limited number of speech sounds or articulation difficulties.
- Difficulty producing specific speech sounds e.g., lisps
- Difficulty talking fluently e.g., stuttering.
- Problems with voice e.g., hoarse, husky voice, losing their voice altogether.
- Difficulty with appropriate social use of language.
- Need alternative ways to communicate to support or replace speech.
- Difficulty with phonics causing literacy issues.

How We Work

Assessment and intervention can be offered wherever best suits the child and their family e.g. in clinic, at home or at pre-school/school. Telehealth sessions can also be provided if appropriate. After school sessions can be provided.

We know that working as a team will achieve better outcomes, so we liaise with other relevant people involved in the child's care e.g., teachers, GP, allied health team.

Following assessment an individualised intervention plan will be agreed with parents. This will outline goals, frequency of sessions and timeframes.

Intervention often involves work on the child's environment e.g., educating and training communication partners alongside direct work with the child.

For therapy to be effective, a therapy support person is generally needed to help with home practice of work given in therapy sessions.
